Hours & Setup Policies/Procedures

The show is open to the public from 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM, on Saturday, and 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM, on Sunday. The setup hours on Friday, are from 8:00 AM until 9:00 PM, and on Saturday, from 7:00 AM until 10:00 AM. Dealers can drive their vehicles/trailers into the building, but drive-in access will be restricted due to narrow entrance. Exhibitors should unload their vehicles and immediately remove their vehicle from the building before setting up. If drive-in access becomes impossible, then you may unload your vehicle from either the front or rear of the building, but please do not block the doorways with your vehicles.

Acceptance Process

A letter indicating the status of your application will be sent after the application is received. The letter will state whether the application has been accepted, declined or is on-hold (pending) while we complete the show floor plan. If placed in a “pending” status, you will receive an accepted or declined notice at least 21 days before the show.

Floorplans, Badges, etc.

Floorplans and setup instructions will be available to you on the day of the show. We will also be mailing out the floor plan and setup instructions, but if you need to know this information right away, please provide us with an email address once we complete the layout. Exhibitor badges will be available for pickup at the show.

Rules & Other General Information

Show Hours: Please try to keep your display space open to the public for the duration of the show. We realize that you must get home, but we have had many a complaint from the public that dealers have already started taking merchandise off the tables, or layouts were already breaking down, before the show is over. The show is open to the public from 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM, on Saturday, and from 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM, on Sunday. Setup runs from 8:00 AM – 9:00 PM, on Friday, and from 7:00 AM -10:00 AM, on Saturday. In the event these hours change, you will be notified. Dealers should arrive no later than 9:00 AM, on Saturday. On Friday, the building will be vacated at 9:00 PM. On Saturday, the building will be vacated at approximately 5:15 PM. All dealers and layout exhibitors will be readmitted at 9:00 AM, on Sunday, and must vacate the building by 9:00 PM, on Sunday.

Badges: Dealer/Exhibitor badges are to be used by only those working at a dealer table or assembling operating displays. These badges must always be worn, including setup, public show hours and move-out. Only persons with these badges will be allowed in the hall during Friday/Saturday setup and the Sunday breakdown of displays. Badges are not to be given to any person for the purpose of shopping during non-public hours, or to access the show early. For security purposes, after 4:00 PM, during the Sunday breakdown, have all your members wear the Exhibitor Badge, so we know that they are in the building legitimately. This is due to an incident with other shows when items were stolen from a vendor during breakdown and after 4:00 PM. Anyone without an Exhibitor Badge, during the Sunday breakdown, will be asked why they are in the building.

Security: Fresno County Fairground's security guards are normally on duty 24 hours. FMRC assumes no responsibility for dealer/exhibitor loss. We recommend that you cover your display on Friday and Saturday nights. When you leave on Friday or Saturday, please take all your personal belongings with you. **NO ONE** is admitted into the building under any circumstances before and after the FMRC staff leaves the building.

Parking: Any parking fees required by the Fresno County Fairgrounds are the responsibility of the exhibitor, but the fairgrounds does allow FMRC to issue parking passes for exhibitor vehicles, which allows you to park in the vicinity of the Train Show Building.

Reservations: Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations will only be granted after FMRC receives the returned reservation form in the mail, and there is space available. Reservations will only be considered when the proper reservation form is received. If we have no space for your reservation, we will contact you, and work out an alternative arrangement/location for your display. **RESERVATIONS FOR LAYOUT DISPLAYS MUST BE IN TO FMRC BY NO LATER THAN April 30st, 2026, BUT I HIGHLY ADVISE YOU TO GET IT IN ASAP—DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE!!!** If I do not hear anything from you by April 30th, I will start to ask other layouts that are available.
